Codgers Cottage by Suzsi Mandeville

Codgers Cottage is a one-act comedy play written by Australian author Suzsi Mandeville. Set in a nursing home teetering on the edge of closure, the story centres around a group of quirky elderly residents who are just managing to get by. Their routine is upended when a well-meaning new nurse accidentally mixes up their medications, leading to a series of chaotic and hilarious events. The play offers a humorous yet poignant look at aging, community, and resilience.

Mandeville, known for her engaging storytelling, brings her signature wit to this production. Her other works include the time-travel adventure novel Escape from the Valley of the Kings.

Dirty Deeds at the Diggings (from the book of plays Just for Fun -Adapted by Mary McMahon).

Dirty Deeds at the Diggings is a lively, comedic one-act melodrama set during the Australian gold rush. The play centres on a hardworking father striving to strike gold, his endearing yet naive daughter, a scheming villain intent on stealing their claim, and a gallant hero who arrives to thwart the villain's plans, rescue the damsel, and restore justice. This fast-paced skit delivers a hearty dose of humour and classic melodramatic flair in just ten minutes.

The production embraces the traditional elements of 19th-century melodrama, encouraging audience participation through enthusiastic boos for the villain and cheers for the hero. It also features period-appropriate songs, inviting the audience to sing along and immerse themselves in the historical setting.
